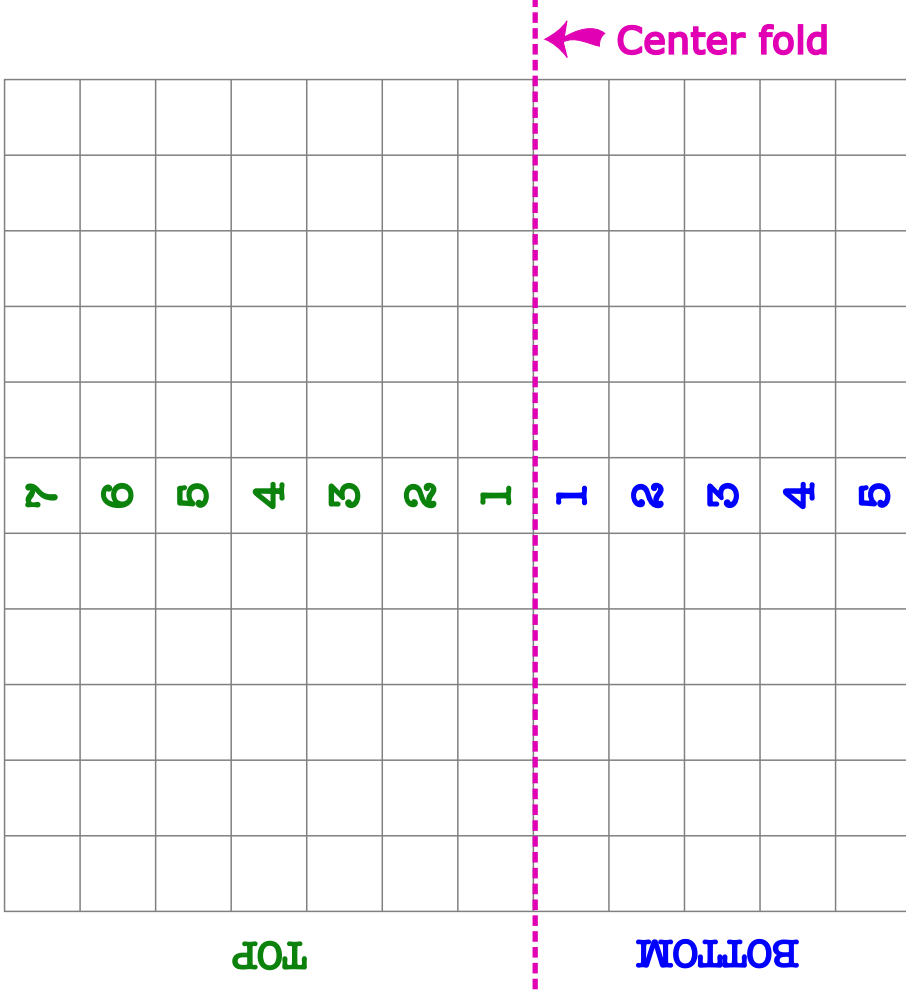
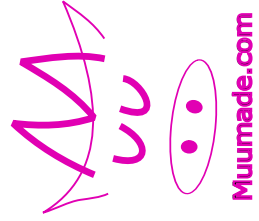


Pop-up Card Template



Remember: **TOP** + **BOTTOM** = 9 or less



1. Print out the template (scale: 100%) and cut the sheet in half, separating the template from the instructions.
2. Prepare a sheet of colored paper in the same size as the template, for the inside of the card.
3. Fold the two sheets in half along the 'center fold' and put the colored paper inside and the template facing out. Hold them together with paper clips.
4. Make 1, 2 or 3 pop-up objects. (See the online instructions for suggestions regarding their sizes.)
5. Measure the height of each object, which gives its TOP number. Then use the magical equation: **TOP + BOTTOM = 9 or less**, to get its BOTTOM number. In the column where you want to place the object, mark the horizontal lines just above the TOP number and just below the BOTTOM number.
6. Cut along the sides of the columns to make pop-up supports, stopping at the horizontal marks that you made in the previous step.
7. Bend the columns inward to make new creases.
8. Decorate the background if you wish.
9. Apply glue or double-sided tape from the bottom end of each column up to its new crease. Place the objects onto the columns.
10. Decorate and attach the outside layer of the card.

Now your pop-up card is finished!
